### **PROJECT INFORMATION**

V. Sattui Winery, a historic Napa Valley destination since 1885, embarked on a major renovation of its deli, tasting room, and marketplace in alignment with its 50th anniversary in 2025. The 2,500-square-foot expansion aimed to elevate the guest experience without halting operations, as closure risked significant revenue loss and staff disruption. To achieve this, the winery partnered with Kitchens To Go and Mobile Modular to deploy a temporary, fully equipped mobile kitchen and a spacious 36' x 60' modular structure that served as a tasting room and marketplace. Nestled in shaded picnic areas, the temporary buildings maintained V. Sattui's signature rustic charm while accommodating guest needs.

Ensuring compliance with Napa County's zoning and environmental regulations required careful planning, including utility hookups and ADAcompliant access. Despite some permitting delays, the modular spaces were thoughtfully designed to replicate the winery's warm ambiance and support seamless guest flow. Staff and visitors quickly embraced the highquality experience, with the mobile kitchen enabling fresh, on-site culinary offerings and the modular marketplace supporting wine tastings and sales. These solutions allowed V. Sattui to continue delighting hundreds of thousands of visitors with minimal disruption during its year-long transformation.
